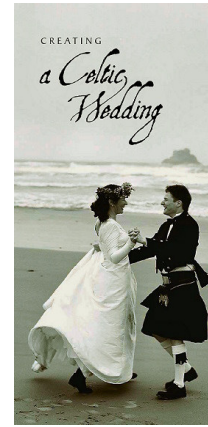


*Wedding Traditions and Celebrations from the Celtic Isles of
